2008 Scholarship Application

The York City chapter of Dollars for Scholars is an affiliate of Scholarship America. York City Dollars for Scholars provides scholarship assistance and academic support services to students who are residents of the City of York and attend one of three area schools: William Penn Senior High School, York County School of Technology, and York County High School. We strive to provide scholarship funding to all eligible candidates although no applicant is guaranteed funding.

To be eligible to apply for 2008 scholarship funding, applicants must be a senior attending one of the three schools listed above, must graduate at the end of the 2007-2008 school year, must have applied to at least one accredited post-secondary institution, and must have submitted a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the United States Department of Education prior to March 1, 2008. Students who meet these eligibility criteria may complete and submit this application to the York City Dollars for Scholars.
